

1. Go to below url:
<https://www.oracle.com/java/technologies/javase-jdk15-downloads.html>
From there you can download the **latest JDK(Java Development Kit) - 15.**
2. If you have already downloaded the JDK to your machine, no need to worry! You can learn Core Java even by **using the JDK 8 version.**
3. Open your terminal/command prompt and type **javac --version**
4. If you get the correct JDK version, then all are okay. If you get a **javac command not found error** in the command prompt, then you need to set the path variable in your machine.
5. In windows, Just Right click on my computer icon and go to properties, then click on advanced properties.
6. From there, you can go to the **environment variables** section.
7. In the environment variables dialog, just click on the path variable row and click edit.
8. Now you should add your JDK path. Normally JDK is installed in C:\Program Files\Java\jdk15\bin\ directory. You can add that path.
